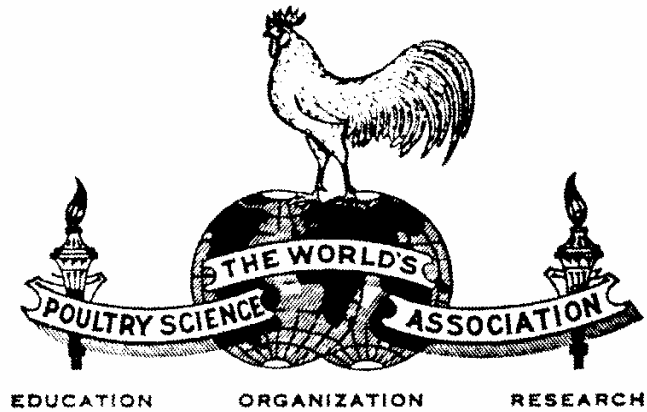


30th Poultry Science Symposium
